Understanding Rail Course

This two-day course provides an up-to-date, high level overview of all aspects of the rail industry including the operational, technical, legislative and business environment.

Understanding Rail is a great opportunity for anyone new to working in the rail industry to learn about rail directly from key members in the industry. It also works as a great 'refresher' for those in the industry who feel they need updating on the latest innovations, issues and ideas in rail. Presenters include CEOs, Executive General Managers, Directors and others currently working in rail, all sharing their wealth of knowledge with attendees.

An Insight into Railway Signalling Course

This one-day course is a joint venture between the ARA and the Institution of Railway Signalling Engineers Australasian Section (IRSE). It provides an insight into the technology, processes and principles used by Railway Signal Engineers.

The course is prepared and presented by Signalling Engineers who have worked in rail for 30-40 years, the course is designed for those required to liaise with Signal Engineers, interface to railway signal systems, coordinate with signalling projects or provide operational requirements for signalling systems.

An Insight into Rolling Stock Engineering Course

This one-day course is a joint venture between the ARA and the Railway Technical Society of Australasia (RTSA). It provides an insight into the principles used in the design, manufacture and maintenance of railway rolling stock including locomotives, passenger cars, multiple unit trains and freight wagons.

The course is designed for those new to the industry and those required to liaise with rail engineering people involved with rolling stock acquisition, operation and whole of life support projects and the interface between each of the rail operating systems.

An Insight into Track Engineering Course

This one-day course is a joint venture between the ARA and the Railway Technical Society of Australasia (RTSA). It provides an insight to the technology, processes and principles that are used by Railway Track Engineers.

The course is designed for those required to liaise with Track Engineers, assist with the design of railway track, coordinate with track engineering projects and/or maintenance activities and provide an understanding of the interface between track and other railway systems.
