Criteria

The 2026 TrackSAFE Award recognises the diverse range of activities organisations have implemented to promote rail safety messages to the community. These may include rail safety advertising campaigns, education and teaching resources and/or other community focused initiatives designed to improve safety on and around rail.

TrackSAFE encourages nominations from rail organisations, governments (local, state and federal), police and community groups.

Multiple nominations

If submitting multiple nominations, please submit a new entry for each initiative/project.

Questions to address

1. What is your organisation's name?
2. What is the title of the nominated initiative/project?
3. What is the initiative's timeframe (start, end and/or ongoing)?
4. Describe the objective and activity, including how its implementation has helped build awareness of rail safety in the community, and its impact. Please provide any other relevant information.
5. Do you give permission for key points from your nomination to be shared with the wider rail industry?

Supporting documents

- a. Supporting Material: Must provide evidence of their direct involvement in their chosen activity/project examples, any such evidence will be kept confidential to the judges. Note that supporting material in the form of a CV is unlikely to satisfy the criteria. *10-page limit.*
- b. Endorsement: If you are self-nominating, a second/third party endorsement and referee contact details must be provided.
- c. Overview of Nomination: Please upload an overview of your nomination with contact details for inclusion in the Rail Knowledge Bank and awards website. *One-page limit.*
